STUDENTS LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY/ AFTERNOON TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

In order to avoid disrupting classes throughout the day, if a student must leave school early, please send a note with the student to take to the office upon arrival.

If there will be a change in the way your child will leave school in the afternoon please communicate this with your child prior to their arrival at school. Students will not be allowed to ride alternate buses and bus notes will not be allowed.

ATTENDANCE

When your child is absent, please call 812-435-8284 to report the absence. An answering machine is available 24 hours a day. An absence is declared truant if not cleared by the parent or guardian within 3 days. If your child sees a doctor, please ensure that a doctor’s statement is turned in to the attendance office.

NURSE

The Nurse's Office is open daily from 7:15 a.m.—2:30 p.m. Students are to report to the nurse during those hours for first aid and illness. All freshmen and new students entering EVSC are required to have a school physical, and all students need up-to-date immunization records. It is very important that students with allergies, asthma, diabetes, and seizures have a current action plan on file in the nurse’s office. If your doctor needs a copy of the action plan, you may pick one up in the nurse’s office. If a student requires any type of medication, all of these need to be in the nurse’s office in the original bottle along with written permission of a parent or guardian stating what the medication is for, the correct dose, and time it should be administered.
