Scholarship Application Requirements

#### 1. College you plan to attend:

- Must choose only 1 college for application
- Need 1 college acceptance letter
- If you change schools:
  - you <u>must</u> notify counselor immediately
  - Turn in updated acceptance letter
- Several scholarships are dependent on which school you are planning to attend

### Scholarship Application Requirements

#### 2. FAFSA:

 Must submit either the Student Aid Report(SAR) page showing Student Aid Index (SAI) and include Student Name from the FAFSA.

#### or

- Complete the Federal Student Aid Estimator and submit that SAI score.
- No SAI turned in = 0 points awarded.

Please submit your financial package from your school - *May be delayed this year*

The SAI is **not** a measure of how much student aid you'll receive or how much you'll pay for college. Schools use your SAI to determine your federal student aid eligibility.

Based on the **eligibility criteria**, you may be eligible for a **Federal Pell Grant** of up to \$7395.00. You may also be eligible for other federal, state, or institutional grants, scholarships, and/or workstudy programs. Scholarship Application Requirements

# Scholarship Reality Check

Searching and applying for scholarships is too much work!

#### **REALITY:**

- The effort you put into scholarships is proportional to the likelihood of receiving a scholarship.
- After you have completed a few applications, the amount of work is reduced, as most applications will have similar questions and previously written essays can often be easily adapted to other scholarship opportunities.
- The amount of work is minimal when compared to the potential reward.

You would have to work full-time for 2 ½ week, earning \$10/ hour to earn \$1,000. You might spend 2-3 hours on a scholarship application which awards \$1,000.

# Scholarship Tips and Tricks

- Pay attention to deadlines
- Read the application requirements
- Apply for small \$ scholarships
- Transcripts
  - See counselor or Mrs. Haag
  - Does it need to be official?
- Letter of recommendation
  - Give plenty of notice!
  - Thank you notes!!
- Proofread!
